



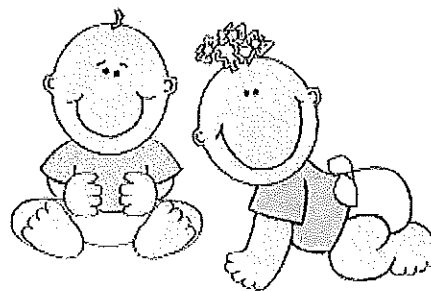

- When setting up your child's bed with us, please make sure you first ask about the supplies for the cribs.
- SMLCS provides your child with an individual space to house the following necessary items you need to bring for your child's daily use.
 - Disposable diapers
 - Disposable wipes
 - Cream or Ointment (if used, Medication Form is required)
 - Already prepared bottles (formula, milk, or juice)
 - Cereal (if used)
 - Baby Food (jars or finger food if used)
 - Complete Change of Clothes
 - Several Bibs (snap on)
 - Blanket (as per SMLCS specification)
 - Pacifier (if used)
 - Your child's schedule and little habits

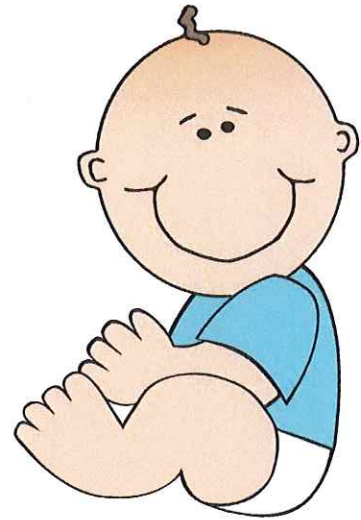
